Fall Colors Tour at Starved Rock!

Come experience the beauty of fall colors at Starved Rock. Starved Rock stands on the south bank of the Illinois River, opposite the village of Utica, about nine miles west of Ottawa. Deep canyons lie to the east and west of Starved Rock, along the Illinois River. The day begins with a lunch buffet at 11:00am in the main dining room. At noon we will board the trolley and go to the Ottawa Canyon for a guided hike. The hike is less than 1 mile round trip, it is not a paved trail. People who do not want to hike can stay in the trolley. At 1:00 we will begin the public fall colors trolley tour. The tour concludes at the Lodge which will give you free time to look around the grounds. From 3:00-4:00 we will take our boat ride. After the boat ride we will head back home.

Transportation, lunch buffet and tickets for trolley and boat ride are included in fee.
