

## PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS

### CARDINAL DRIVE PARK (MAP MARKER 1)

2708 Cardinal Drive

This one acre park, with parking, has playground equipment suitable for ages 3-5, a small shaded pavilion and a horseshoe pit.

### COMMUNITY CENTER PARK (MAP MARKER 2)

3705 Pheasant Drive

This 11.6 acre park, with parking, has numerous amenities including playground equipment suitable for infants to ages 3-7, bocce ball court, sled hill, soccer fields, picnic shelter, shuffleboard and hiking/jogging/bicycle trail.

### COUNTRYSIDE PARK (MAP MARKER 3)

4360 Euclid Avenue

This six acre park has playground equipment suitable for ages 3-12. It also features tennis courts, baseball/softball diamond and basketball court. Side street parking is available.

### CREEKSIDE PARK (MAP MARKER 4)

3461 Crestwood Lane

This one acre park has playground equipment suitable for ages 3-5. Side street parking is available.

### CREEKSIDE WOOD PARK (MAP MARKER 5)

4421 Dawngate Lane

This 7.3 acre park is nice for hiking, jogging or bicycling. Side street parking is available.

### FLOREY PARK (MAP MARKER 6)

3300 Campbell Street

This 22 acre park, with parking, has numerous amenities including playground equipment suitable for ages 5-12, baseball diamond, open field, picnic shelter, tennis courts, basketball court, sand volleyball court and hiking/jogging/bicycle trail. Picnic rental opportunities available.

### KIMBALL HILL PARK (MAP MARKER 8)

2905 Meadow Drive (behind Jewel/Osco)

This 25 acre park, with parking, has numerous amenities including playground equipment suitable for ages 6-12, baseball diamonds, open field, picnic shelter, picnic area/grills, sand volleyball court and hiking/jogging/bicycle trail, pond, fishing, horseshoes. Picnic rental opportunities available.

### NORTH SALK PARK (MAP MARKER 9)

3160 Owl Drive

This 17 acre park, with parking, has playground equipment suitable for ages 6-12, hiking/jogging/bicycle trail, and access to the sled hill. Our 12-hole Disc Golf course begins here as well.

### PLUM GROVE PARK (MAP MARKER D)

4001 Park Drive

This 8.5 acre park has numerous amenities including playground equipment suitable for infants to ages 6-12, tennis courts, picnic shelter, banquet facility, basketball courts, roller hockey, skate park and picnic area/grills. Picnic and banquet rental opportunities available.

### SOUTH SALK PARK (MAP MARKER 10)

This 22 acre park, with parking, has numerous amenities including playground equipment suitable for infants to ages 6-12, baseball diamond, basketball court and hiking/jogging/bicycle trail.

### SUNSET PARK (MAP MARKER 7)

This 3.9 acre park, with parking, has two soccer fields.

### WAVERLY PARK (MAP MARKER 11)

This 4.7 acre park, with parking, has numerous amenities including new playground equipment suitable for infants to ages 6-12, walking/biking path, baseball diamond, free-play court, including basketball and soccer, and picnic shelter.

## SLED HILL INFORMATION

The lit sled hill in North Salk Park will be open provided that there is at least 3 inches of snow and the wind chill is not colder than -20 degrees. A RED flag will indicate that the sled hill is closed. A YELLOW flag will indicate that the sled hill is open but is unsupervised and caution should be exercised.

## KIMBALL HILL POND INFORMATION

With the cold weather coming, we are encouraging parents to talk to their children about the dangers of walking on or playing around any frozen bodies of water. In particular, please advise them to beware of the pond located in Kimball Hill Park. The Rolling Meadows Park District staff will monitor the thickness of the ice and a RED flag and RED barrels will be placed at the pond when conditions are unsafe. When the thickness is safe for skating the barrels will be removed and a YELLOW flag will be raised to indicate that the pond is safe for skating. However, caution should always be used when on frozen bodies of water. Ice fishing is not permitted at Kimball Hill Pond.

## WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

Local school closings/cancellations due to weather do not always affect the cancellation of Park District programs. Our Early Childhood programming will follow District 15 closing procedures for inclement weather. Youth basketball practices that take place at our local schools generally are canceled if District 15 is closed.
