Registration for Preschool School Year 2018-2019

Pre-registration for fall preschool will begin on Monday, January 15-26. At this time children currently enrolled in the preschool program and their siblings may register for Fall 2017 Preschool & Pre-kindergarten classes. This is in advance of the general registration. There will be a \$25.00 non-refundable deposit with a balance due in July. Parents can choose to sign up for an automatic payment plan. To register a proof of age will be required for children entering the program for the first time. Pre-registration forms will be distributed in the classroom the week of January 9th.
